Barn Preservation

During the last century, New Boston lost almost all of its working farms. The last remaining dairy herd was sold off in 2002. In fact, only six dairy herds now remain in Hillsborough County. Some farming continues, but the subsistence farming which once was the general way of life here has completely disappeared.

Barns remain as symbols of this vanished way of life. The original settlers gave as much care to their barns as they did to their houses. The survival of their livestock during our harsh winters depended on it. The early barns are masterpieces of design and function, built using massive hand-hewn beams and intricate mortise and tenon bracing. They are so well designed that, as long as the roof remains intact, a barn can survive for hundreds of years.

Historic barns are found in every part of the town. Perhaps the best-known is the "Cement Barn," a so-called "estate" barn built in 1881 by J. R. Whipple on the 1,000 acre farm which supplied his three Boston hotels. It is now owned by the Daniels family. The Horse Farm barn off Bedford Rd., the Nixon barn on Old Coach Rd., the Priest Bradford barn on Bradford Lane, and the Roger Noonan barn on Colburn Rd. are fine examples of early structures. An inventory by the Historical Society of all existing barns in the town is underway.

The question arises: what purpose do they now serve? Unless they are used for agriculture, they are essentially only garages or storage facilities. Their upkeep presents the property owner with a significant expense. But everyone agrees that they should be saved – they express the rural character of the town and highlight its landscapes. Whenever a barn is lost, everyone feels saddened to some degree.

We have lost a great number of barns over the past fifty years. Some have burned down; some have collapsed due to neglect; some have been dismantled and sold as material for "designer" interiors. Recognizing this, the state is attempting to encourage preservation whenever possible. RSA 79-D enables the Board of Selectmen to grant a Barn Preservation Easement to owners of historic barns and outbuildings. Up to a 75% reduction in property taxes on the building for periods ranging from 10 to 30 years may be obtained, which includes a commitment on the part of the town not to raise valuations during the span of the easement. As of 2004, four barns in New Boston have been protected in this way. Application forms are available at the Selectmens' office.

Another option is for the owner to convert a barn to another economic use while retaining its exterior look. The New Boston Clinic and the Apple Barn are good examples of this approach.
